**Design:** In last months newsletter, a few more of the newer designs by *Rosewood Manor* were featured, however, I still missed one of them -

**ROSE:BUTTONS - Barnwood Buttons:** This is a very long oblong piece (finished size just over 21" on 32 count linen). The flowers on this design are not stitched but created with gorgeous cream coloured buttons (20) of varying shapes and sizes and some have a texture or pattern on them. Fluttering above is a pearly butterfly shaped button. Underneath the row of flowers is the verse, *When one tugs at a single thing in nature he finds it attached to the rest of the world.* Karen has designed this piece to be stitched on the new fabric known as 'Picture This Plus' and the colour she has chosen is *Barnwood*. We do not currently have this Belfast fabric in NZ, therefore an alternative dark coloured fabric would have to be chosen (e.g. Belfast : Dirty Linen, Raw or Country) so that the light thread colour and the cream buttons would show off beautifully. Of this design, Karen writes, "I read this verse from John Muir and thought it had a lot to say about how fragile Mother Earth really is and then when I saw the rich colour of this 'Picture This Plus' fabric and discovered the beautiful buttons from Durango Button Company and I felt that it all came together to illustrate the verse perfectly".

A reminder that there are scissors available for this specific task. They have small serrated blades, a gold finish and the finger holes are of a good size.

**Magazines:** Over the past few months several new issues of magazines have arrived at the Gallery. Some of these only remain on sale for about six weeks, but some titles are kept and on sale until they are sold out. These latter titles are - Sampler & Antique Needlework Quarterly, Just CrossStitch and Inspirations.

**SANQ 68 - Samper & Antique Needlework Quarterly (Fall 2012):** A 1787 Dutch Sampler; a review by Jacqueline Holdsworth (of *Needleprint*) of the vast Fellers\* collection of embroidery (including samplers from the 17th century & needlework items belonging to English authors & royalty), an 1814 sampler and a look at a collection of tartan ware needlework items, including pincushions, tatting shuttles and needleholders, all clad in various tartan plaids. \$21.50

**SANQ 69 - Sampler & Antique Needlework Quarterly (Winter 2012):** An 1835 polychrome sampler featuring a menagerie of birds, dogs and butterflies amid a swirling acorn & flower border, a look at the book of embroidery designs compiled by 17th-century Thomas Trevelyan, who offers a look at not only the intricacies of everyday life in Elizabethan England but also the delicate and exquisite embroidery patterns of the day, an elegant purse ornament with motifs and stitches reminiscent of Elizabethan dress, an 1821 sampler featuring a religious poem and a delicate ornament of specialty stitches and dimensional finishing from the hands of Merry Cox, plus a look at a collection of Scottish souvenir ware & needlework items made by the Smith family in Mauchline, Scotland. \$21.50

**INSPIRE 77 - Inspirations (#77):** One of the most beautiful needlework magazines available today that features all types of needlework & embroidery. An opulent tassel with superb stumpwork & needlelace, a long & short satin stitched royal blue fairy wren, a sophisticated silk coathanger embellished with beautiful roses and lilac blooms, a Californian poppy & bumble bee miniature stumpwork, gorgeous needlecase with traditional Jacobean fruit & flower motifs & an exquisite whitework lavender sachet featuring a Scottish thistle. \$19.90
