
What's New At Heirlooms?

She was so disappointed, as she had not missed a show for 18 years! However, her new designs were on display and these are -

JBW 271 - Alphabet Hearts: The third design in her new Stitch-A-Long series. As its title suggests - alphabet letters and hearts of all different styles and sizes, all worked in varying shades of rose pink and greens. \$18.50 JBW 272 - Alphabet Cats: Two little cats - a momma and a kitty, each shape being created by Judy's clever use of letters of the alphabet. Finish as hanging ornaments as per the models with silver pussy cat charms hanging from the bottom of each piece or frame the pieces separately or stitch both together and frame as one. \$10.00




NOTE: In stock are a few of the original design - JBW 065: Homeward Bound. There is a model of this design hanging on the wall in the Needlework Gallery.




JBW 274 French Country ~ Poodle




JBW 275 French Country ~ Umbrella

SWT:SE 023 - Lady Dunmore's Sampler: A beautiful sampler with lots of stitches - Cross Stitch, Square Eyelets, Couched Coils, Scotch Stitch, Rhodes Heart, Diagonal Oblique Herringbone, Satin Stitch, Diamond Eyelet, Backstitch, and more - all worked on a 28 count Light Mocha Cashel Linen with rose, cream, olive green shades of DMC stranded cottons, a silk overdyed thread, and a silver metallic thread. This is then embellished with silver paillettes, and dark iris, old rose and silver beads. Just glorious! \$79.50
