Embroidery is a wonderful narrator - it can tell stories about modern trends and current events, give insights into timeless cultures and age-old traditions, even reveal great moments in history in a truly unique way.

It also has the ability to tell a much more personal story, to take us on one person's stitching journey and allow us to share their passion as we follow their progress. This book tells such a story.

Julie Kniedl's passion was three-dimensional embroidery,
the accurate and artful depiction of plants with needle and thread,
completely removed from the constraints of a flat, fabric background.
She created embroideries that can be touched, picked up and turned around.
Her subject matter was often ordinary and everyday - a pear, a lemon and even a humble cauliflower,
but with her insatiable curiosity, unerring eye for detail and ingenious approach,
she turned each one into a magical embroidery adventure.
Using a small range of readily available materials and simple embroidery stitches and techniques,
Julie was able to capture the fragile and ephemeral beauty of flowers, fruit and seedpods with a needle and thread.
Her ability to look at an object and interpret it in a clever and inventive way that can be replicated by others
adds another important page to the embroidery story.

While Julie's own journey ended unexpectedly when she passed away in August 2017, her wonderful embroidery legacy remains and will continue to encourage us to push the boundaries, break the rules, and, as she did, discover exciting new ways with needle and thread.






